

Mark pool and deck layout





Excavation and Base

Dig Day

- Carefully excavate the pool area
- Shape shallow and deep ends
- Remove or reuse soil as planned

This is when the project really starts to take shape.



Pool Install

1 Fiberglass Pool

- Pool shell is set and leveled
- Filled with water and backfilled for stability

2 Vinyl Liner Pool

- Pool walls installed and reinforced
- Concrete collar added for strength
- Smooth pool floor and liner installed



Plumbing & Electrical

Behind the Scenes Work

- Install plumbing for circulation and filtration
- Set pool lights (if included)
- Bonding and electrical work for safety
- All systems inspected and tested



Pool Equipment

The Pool's "Engine"

1. Pump and filter installed
 - Heater or salt system (if selected)
 - Equipment tested for proper operation



Backfill and Grading

Shaping the Area Around Your Pool


- Backfill around the pool
- Compact soil for long-term stability
- Grade yard for proper drainage
- Prepare area for concrete decking



Pool Decking

Your Poolside Living Space

- Deck layout formed to design
- Reinforcement added for durability
- Concrete poured and finished
- Options: broom finish, stamped, or decorative



Pool Startup

Bringing the Pool to Life


- Pool filled to operating level
- System started and checked
